



## Secondary Uniform Policy

### Rational

- To promote group identity and equality among students.
- To promote the school's name outside of school
- To encourage respect amongst students and teachers.

### Objectives

- To ensure that the whole school is in the correct uniform.
- To inform parents of the correct way to wear the uniform.
- To develop a sense of belonging in a community.
- To help identify students on educational visits
- To encourage students to take pride in their appearance.
- To reflect the school in a positive manner in the wider community.

### Students

- To ensure the uniform is worn correctly before entering and leaving the school.
- To look presentable throughout the school day.
- To wear the correct uniform during school excursions.
- To ensure that their uniform looks clean and tidy.

### Staff

- To be positive role models and lead by example by following the staff dress code.
- To ensure that all students are conforming to the School Policy.
- To have consistency in the implementation of the Uniform Policy.

### Parents

- To adhere to the policy.
- To ensure their children are provided with the correct uniform including the P.E. uniform.

Note: Students not dressed in their correct uniform will not be allowed to participate on school outings/field trips.

### **Wearing of Uniform**

Students should be dressed in full uniform each day. Student may ONLY come to school in their PE kit on PE days. A detailed outline of the required uniform is found on the next page and in the student planner. It is an expectation that both parents and students adhere to the required dress code and ensure that students are neatly and appropriately presented at all times.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ McKenzie tartan straight cut skirt, calf to ankle length or loose fitting navy blue trousers.</li> <li>○ White linen shirt with school logo on left side.</li> <li>○ School sweatshirt/fleece jacket (available term 2) – <b><u>NO HOODS</u></b></li> <li>○ Plain black/navy coat, no logos.</li> <li>○ Plain black or navy head wear (optional).</li> <li>○ Plain, flat black footwear.</li> <li>○ Abaya – Abaya should be non-black.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Navy blue trousers.</li> <li>○ White linen shirt with school logo on left side.</li> <li>○ <b><u>School tartan tie (to be tied properly and worn up to the neck) must be worn at all times</u></b></li> <li>○ Shirt must be tucked in at all times</li> <li>○ Black footwear</li> <li>○ Plain white T shirt or vest to be worn under shirt (optional).</li> <li>○ School sweatshirt/fleece jacket (available term 2) – <b><u>NO HOODS</u></b></li> <li>○ Plain black/navy coat, no logos, School cap only may be worn at break times only.</li> <li>○ No black trousers and jumpers are allowed.</li> <li>○ Hair should be natural and well-groomed</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Plain navy shorts/ trousers</li> <li>○ School polo shirt, a plain white vest may be worn under shirt (optional)</li> <li>○ Trainers</li> </ul>
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### Jewellery

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ One pair of small stud or sleeper earrings</li> <li>○ Watch (<b><u>NO SMART WATCHES DURING EXAM PERIODS</u></b>)</li> <li>○ No make-up or nail varnish is to be worn.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Watch (<b><u>NO SMART WATCHES DURING EXAM PERIODS</u></b>)</li> <li>○ No earrings, necklaces or jewellery.</li> </ul>

### Hair styles

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Hair for both girls and boys should be conventional in style. Hair dye is not permitted.</li> <li>○ Hair accessories for girls should be in the school colours.</li> <li>○ Hijab/scarves should be navy or black</li> </ul>
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
