#### The Use of Mobile Phone Policy

#### Purpose

This policy outlines the rules regarding the use of mobile phones in school to maintain a safe, focused, and respectful learning environment, in line with the expectations of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education (Circular 4, March 2025).

## 1. Applicability

This policy applies to all students who attend Newton British School Muraikh

## 2. Policy Guidelines

#### 2.1 Primary

• Students are not allowed to use mobile phones in school. If you wish to raise a concern regarding this, please speak directly with the Head of Primary.

#### 2.2 Secondary

- Students are permitted to bring mobile phones to school, however;
- Phones must be handed to form tutors every morning, to be returned at the end of the day.
- If a student is late, they are to hand phone in to subject teacher in the room or Pastoral lead.
- If a student is found with a mobile phone, it will be confiscated and returned only to a parent at the end of the school day.
- Any misuse, including taking photos/videos without consent, cyberbullying, or accessing inappropriate content, will result in serious disciplinary action, including suspensions.

## 3. Consequences for Policy Violations

- First Offense: Verbal warning and confiscation of the phone for the day.
- Second Offense: Phone confiscated and returned only to a parent at the end of the day.
- Third Offense and more: Further disciplinary action will be considered, including detentions and behaviour agreement contracts.

### 4. Special Considerations

- If a student requires a mobile phone for medical reasons or emergencies, parents must submit a written request to the school for approval.
- Teachers and staff have the authority to confiscate mobile phones if students do not comply with this policy.

### 5. Parent and Student Responsibility

- The school is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged mobile phones.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure their phone is kept secure and used appropriately.

#### 6. Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it remains aligned with Ministry of Education guidelines and school needs.
