Rational

- To promote group identity and equality among students.
- To promote the school's name outside of school
- To encourage respect among students and teachers.

Objectives

- To encourage students to take pride in their appearance.
- To reflect the school in a positive manner in the wider community.
- To develop a sense of belonging in a community.
- To help identify students on educational visits

Students

- To ensure the uniform is worn correctly before entering and leaving the school.
- To look presentable throughout the school day.
- To wear the correct uniform during school excursions.

Staff

- To be positive role models and lead by example by following the staff dress code.
- To ensure that all students conform to the School Policy.

Parents

- To adhere to the policy.
- To ensure their children are provided with the correct uniform including the P.E. uniform.
- To ensure that their uniform looks clean and tidy.

Note: Students not dressed in their correct uniform will not be allowed to participate on school outings/field trips.

Jewellery

Hair styles

- Hair style for girls and boys should be a conventional style
- Hair dye is not permitted
- Hair accessories for girls should be in school colours
- Hijab/scarves should be navy or black
