### Heritage

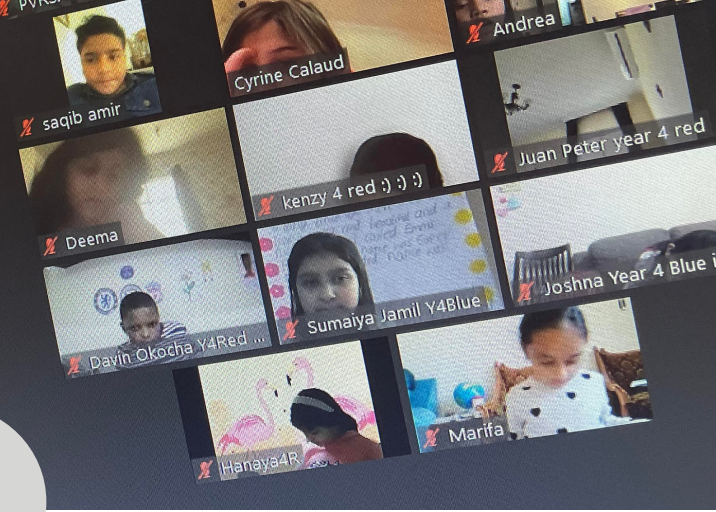
Heritage: Is all that the ancestors left of science, art, architecture, customs and values, and the heritage is divided into two types:

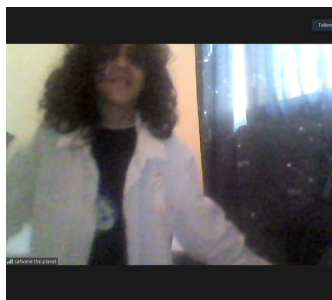
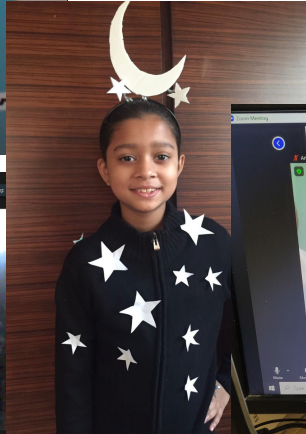
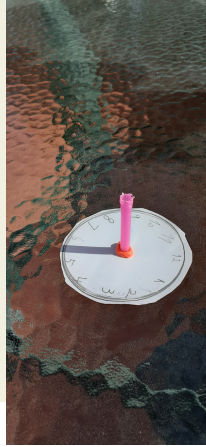
## Road Safety

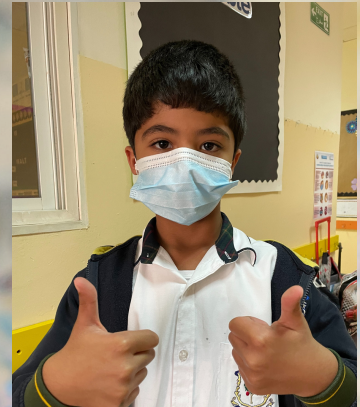
## VALUE OF THE WEEK
