

They will have discussion time and time to reflect on their character.

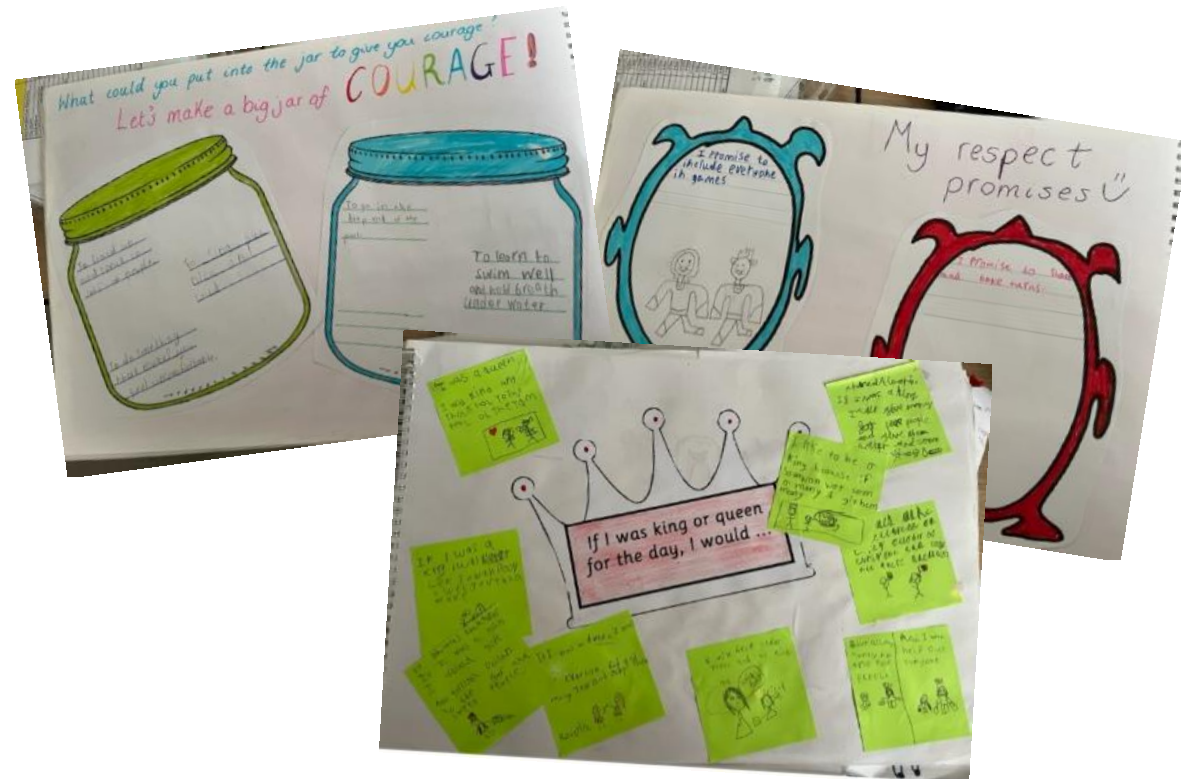
