How to complete the assessment guidelines

English Writing

Please find below the assessment procedures for Reading Writing and Mathematics. This document allows for teachers to work to the National Curriculum expectations efficiently. The document has Expectations for years 1 – 6 in Primary School.

The document works on a points system for writing to ensure that a non-linear approach is taken to assessment. Below are the guidelines of how to use the assessment document to match NBA's grading system.

We use a variety of resources/assessment tools to assess the children's progress and abilities. Below is an overview of how to document and grade children's attainment.

Reading

The recording sheet for guided reading is standardised across all year groups (It comes with a document that lists all CD (content domain) strands for each year group. A Guided reading teacher file must be kept in each class and an exemplar will be provided for each year group during preparation week for the academic year.

Tests will be disseminated by DHOP Academics to ensure that there is standardisation across the whole of primary.

When making your final grading at the end of term please check that the running record from guided reading sessions and your formal assessment correlate to ensure an accurate grading.
