Dear Parents,

Welcome to another exciting academic year at Newton International Academy Smash Library.

Your child will visit the library once a week for stories, lessons, and book selection for the English lesson, and will also visit for the Arabic lesson twice a month.

Each student may borrow one English book, one Arabic book, and one guided reading book. Their teacher will let you know when library class is scheduled.

For urgent matters concerning borrowing and returning or research, the student may come to the library during break time, but he or she needs to present a library pass signed by the tutor or subject teacher.

All students will learn how to navigate the system plus brochures will be share with everyone



The borrowing policy is as follows:

• **Book borrowers should not lend borrowed books to others, as they will be responsible for the replacement and payment of any lost or damaged books.**

• **All books are due on the same day of the following week (with an extension of one week) after which, if unreturned, will be considered overdue. No fines will be imposed but the student will not be allowed to check out more books unless the overdue books are returned.**

• **Overdue notices will be issued every 2 week to be sent to the class teacher and students.**

• **In case of lost or damaged, replacement of a book is encouraged.**

Kindly encourage your Child to take responsibility for their library books

• Help them remember their library day.

• Set aside a specific place in your home for school library books so you don't misplace them.

• If the book is damaged, please don't try to repair it yourself. Have your child show me the damage so I can attempt to fix it using special library mending supplies.
