In Humanities, we began our Mayan Inquiry which has helped us develop many skills such as: teamwork, research, critical thinking, communication and much more! In our groups, we will continue to work hard to produce our end product which is a news report about our chosen topic. We cannot wait to show off our final pieces! In Science, we continued our topic of Animals, Humans and their habitats with a focus on food chains and food webs before studying micro-organisms. Successfully, we carried out a scientific experiment, using the scientific method, to investigate how Mould grows on bread. We used bread, zip-lock bags, soil and bread to help and our results were amazing!



Art has been exciting with the FIFA World Cup competition! We learned two new skills - shading (using oil pastels) and cross-hatching (a shading technique using black pen) to create the Doha Skyline on black paper with the world cup trophy hidden as one of the buildings. 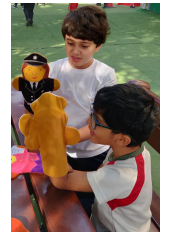
WHAT A FANTASTIC FIRST TERM OF THE SCHOOL YEAR!
